

All related educational/ training activities will be delivered through **digital channels with additional learning activities delivered physically at Vivaldi Hotel, Triq Dragonara, San Ġiljan, STJ 06, Malta**. The Malta Further & Higher Education Authority must be informed immediately of any changes made to these addresses.
2. **Dr Kanika Gupta**, Head of School, has been vested with the legal representation for **European Global Institute of Innovation & Technology (EU Global)**. **Ms Susan Dalli Golden** has been nominated as a **Resident Agent**. The legal representative is responsible for ensuring that all obligations attached to this license are observed at all times.
3. As a **Higher Education Institution, European Global Institute of Innovation & Technology (EU Global)** is licensed to deliver programmes classified up to **Level 8** of the Malta Qualifications Framework, providing that these programmes have been formally recognised and/or accredited by the Malta Further & Higher Education Authority.
